As an industry, member-driven association, we are the premier voice for Newfoundland and Labrador's mineral resource industry.


#### Vision

## 2024 Highlights

With a focus on supporting, promoting, advancing and growing Newfoundland and Labrador's mineral resources industry, 2024 was a pivotal year for Mining Industry NL. Through a series of key activities, we are ensuring Newfoundland and Labrador's mineral resource sector is better positioned to be a supplier of choice for critical minerals and the clean digital technologies they enable.

Key accomplishments for 2024, includes:

#### **Project Portfolio Growth**

Securing more funding and resources to support Mining NL's core operations and to expand services and supports.

#### **Staffing Expansion**

Acquiring extra resources to enable building a core team to better serve and support industry's growth and transformation.

#### **Tools and Resources**

Enhance Mining NL's digital capabilities, including transitioning to a new member and user relationship management platform. This includes implementing a new online membership management platform called GrowthZone to better connect our members and to position the mineral resource ecosystem for enhanced information-sharing.

#### **Outreach and Education**

Building a new outreach and education program. In collaboration with industry, these new outreach initiatives will support industry in attracting youth and talent to our sector, while raising sector visibility and strengthening community connections.

#### **Advocacy and Representation**

From trade and tariffs to land accessibility concerns, including the proposed South Coast Fjords National Marine Conservation Area (NMCA), wind-energy policy recommendations, workforce and labor development challenges, to name a few, Mining NL has been advocating for Newfoundland and Labrador's mineral resources industry and strengthening our sector's visibility and voice.

#### **Global Investment and Promotions**

Mining NL attends mineral industry trade shows, conferences, and events, nationally and internationally to attract investment for our members. In March 2024, Mining NL collaborated with the Atlantic Canada Mining Sector team to lead, coordinate and deliver Canada's Atlantic Edge as part of the PDAC's International Convention, Trade Show and Investors Exchange in Toronto, ON.
